

Listening to people with compassion and reason, it's clear that we don't all function the same way and shouldn't be expected to.



To create workplaces as flexible as we are, a new type of adaptable design element is needed something that allows spaces to transform in real time.


## active partitions designed for change

Flat Move is a design tool that enables new ways of flexible space planning.


Movable modules join together to create agile arrangements that are so much more than just walls.



The various environments that Flat Move enables are far from static. They easily change as needed, depending on the team and their evolving interactions. Building interiors can change over time without additional material waste from construction.





























